

# PRIVACY POLICY B-Parking.nl

We are aware that your trust is in us. We therefore see it as our responsibility to protect your privacy. On this page we will let you know what data we collect when you use our website. That way you understand how we work.

This privacy policy applies to the services of B-parking.nl. You should be aware that B-Parking.nl is not responsible for the privacy policy of other sites and sources. By using this website you accept the privacy policy.

B-Parking.nl respects the privacy of all users of its site and ensures that the personal information about the contact is treated confidentially.

## 1. What data is collected?

When you sign up for one of our services, we ask you for personal details. This data is used to perform the service. The data is stored on secure B-Parking.nl servers or those of a third party. We will not combine this information with other personal information we have.

In the table below you will find an overview of the data that we collect in the context of our services, for which data this data is processed, how long we store this data and on which legal basis.

<b>CCTV (camera surveillance) at parking locations if applicable (Location List)</b>	
What	Camera images and license plates
Duration	4 weeks, or until an observed incident is completed
Purpose	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Security and safety of parking locations</li> <li>- Receive insight into visitor numbers</li> </ul>
Legal basis	Our legitimate interests, namely security in the locations and insights into visitor numbers.

<b>License plate cameras of Location (location list)</b>	
What	License plates
Duration	Duration of the subscription, or the duration of the contracted purchase of a service.
Purpose	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Quick access to parking location without using pass or code</li> <li>- Automatic control of barrier / gate / speedgate</li> <li>- Insightful in visitor numbers for full / free signaling</li> </ul>
Legal basis	The processing is necessary to gauge the occupancy rate in connection with full / free signaling.

<b>Communication by email</b>	
What	If you send an e-mail or other messages to us, it is possible that we keep those messages. Sometimes we also ask you for your personal details that are relevant to the relevant situation.
Duration	Your mail will be saved until the question has been processed. After this, the mail with the corresponding mail traffic will be deleted.
Purpose	We need extra personal information for some questions in order to help you as well as possible with your request or question. We then store this information in order to be able to continue to help as much as possible as long as the request has not yet been resolved

Legal basis	The data is stored on secure ParkingYou servers or those of a third party. We will not combine this information with other personal information we have.

#### **Parking subscription (www.rentaparking.nl)**

Rentaparking.nl	Our parking subscriptions are sold through the service rentaparking.nl. For this we have made a separate privacy policy. If you have questions about the processing of your personal data, we refer you to www.rentaparking.nl.

ParkBeagle	Parking reservations are sold through the service Parkbeagle. For this we have made a separate privacy policy. If you have questions about the processing of your personal data, we refer you to www.parkbeagle.nl.

B-parking.nl will endeavor to ensure that personal data that are processed are correct and accurate. In addition, B-parking.nl will not process more personal data than is necessary. B-parking will also retain personal data for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which this data was collected or further processed in line with the retention periods stated above.

We do not collect or use information for purposes other than the purposes described in this privacy policy unless we have obtained your consent in advance.

## **2. With whom do we share your personal data or which service providers have insight into your personal data?**

We can share your personal data with:

- Certain third parties to whom we may choose to sell, transfer or merge parts of our company or our assets. Alternatively, we can try to acquire or merge other companies. If our business changes anything, the new owners may use your personal information in the same way as stated in this privacy statement;
- Certain third parties or government bodies, insofar as we are obliged to do so pursuant to laws and regulations or government regulations, or if this is necessary to prevent, detect or prosecute criminal offenses or to defend or enforce our rights and interests.

Furthermore, we distinguish two groups regarding the processing of your data to third parties:

- **Service providers who have insight into your data** → We have contracts with service providers who can only understand your data as soon as there is a reason for it. Here we do not actively share data, but they can view the data in the systems as soon as we actively call them in to help us. This is necessary to correct faults and provide you with the right service. These service providers process our personal data on our instruction and under our responsibility. In such cases your personal data will remain under our control. In accordance with our legal obligation, we conclude a processor agreement with these external service providers.
- **Internal employees who understand your data** → We assume that your data is always confidential. Every ParkingYou employee is therefore obliged to maintain confidentiality. This also applies to third parties who have been hired by ParkingYou or who have been appointed in another way to carry out work. Persons who are charged with carrying out technical work on our systems are also bound to secrecy.

In short, everyone who understands your data is charged with a confidentiality obligation.

All data will only be used for the purpose of the relevant application and will not be further distributed.

We require all external parties to respect the security of your personal information and to treat it in accordance with the law. We do not allow our external service providers to use your personal data for their own purposes and only allow them to process your personal data for specific purposes and in accordance with our instructions.

### **3. How do we protect your personal data?**

We have taken appropriate security measures to prevent your personal data from being accidentally lost or opened, altered or disclosed in an unauthorized manner. In addition, we restrict access to your personal information to the necessary employees, contractors and other third parties. They will only process your personal information in our instructions and are subject to a duty of confidentiality.

### **4. Reporting incidents**

If there is unexpected evidence that something has gone wrong with the protection of your personal data, or we suspect that this is the case, we will report this to the AP. If the violation of your personal data may have unfavorable or adverse consequences for you, we will inform you as soon as possible.

### **5. Transfer of data to countries outside the EU**

We do not transfer personal data to countries outside the EU.

### **6. Your rights and the exercise thereof**

You have the following rights, which you can exercise at any time:

#### Right of inspection

You can request us to inspect your personal data.

#### Right to data portability

You can request us to receive your personal data in a digitally readable standard format

#### Right to correction

You can request us to correct your personal data. We will comply with this request if the personal data we process about you is incorrect or incomplete, with due regard to the purposes of the processing.

#### Right of objection

You can object to the further processing of your data for reasons related to your specific situation. You only have this right if we process your personal data on the basis of 'legitimate interest' (see above under 1). We shall comply with this request, unless we have compelling justified grounds for continuing the processing that outweighs your interests, rights and freedoms, or that relate to the institution, exercise or substantiation of a legal claim.

#### Right to restriction

You can request us to limit the processing of your personal data. This will temporarily freeze the personal data until an objection or problem with its processing is resolved.

#### Right to removal

You can request us to delete your personal data. We will comply with this request if:

- We no longer need the data for the purposes of the processing;

- You withdraw your consent (insofar as we process your personal data on the basis of your permission);
- You object to the processing and there are no compelling justified reasons why we do not have to delete the data;
- We have unlawfully processed your personal data; or
- We must delete your data in order to comply with a legal obligation.

We respond within one month of receipt of a request, but reserve the right to extend this period by two months.

We ask you not to publicly place privacy-sensitive information of yourself or others (such as email address, name, address, telephone number) on these channels, but to share your data with us via a private message. B-Building Business will only use the data you share to answer your question and to improve its customer service. Publicly sensitive privacy sensitive data may be removed by B-Building Business.
